Dear Siblings in Christ,

I assisted with a funeral at my home congregation at St. Peter's in Plainfield Township yesterday, and once again I saw close up the beautiful resurrection window in the church. The window depicts Jesus in a white robe standing outside the tomb with the guards/angels almost cowering at the sight. This stunning stained glass window reflects a milestone in biblical history... Easter morning. Each of the four gospel writers tells the Resurrection story, each foretelling what's to come: the church.

On Sunday May 19, we will celebrate the end of the Easter season with Pentecost, which occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and 10 days after his ascension into heaven. The date of Pentecost shifts because Easter is a movable feast without a fixed date, so Pentecost can fall anywhere between the dates of May 10 and June 13.

Last week we heard the Ascension story and how before Jesus ascended, he promised to send his disciples an advocate, the Holy Spirit, to give them understanding and direction. The celebration of Pentecost is the fulfillment of that promise, making it one of the most important feast days of the year as it celebrates the beginning of the church and its mission to the world.

At Sunday's worship service we will hold the Rite of Confirmation and 5 teenagers will be welcomed into the faith community at Arndt's. The five confirmands are: Jackson Hunsicker, Lilly Hunsicker, Rebekka Rymon, Emma Spatig and Gabby Yanders. Join us for worship as we pray, "Come, Holy Spirit".
