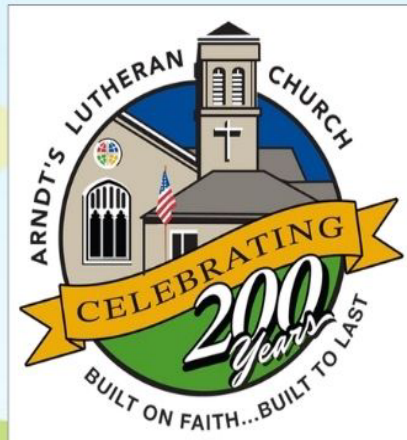

**Save the Date – Lawn Social – June 20<sup>th</sup>:** The Lawn Social Committee has been working hard to plan a spectacular event to celebrate Arndt's 200 years. We hope you will join us on Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> as a volunteer and patron and bring your family and friends to enjoy the festivities. There will be lots of food, live music, children's games, Basket Raffle, Cake Walk, Uncle Louie G's Ice Cream Truck, tours and memorabilia inside the church and more. **Bakery Items Needed For the Cake Walk:** One of our featured events during the upcoming Lawn Social will be an old-fashioned Cake Walk: Participants gather in a large circle around a spinner. When the music starts, everyone in the circle begins walking as directed; when the music stops, everyone stops exactly where they are and the person in charge spins the spinner. When the spinner stops, the person the spinner is pointing at is the winner of that cake walk and receives a cake or pie, or cookies, as their prize. The cost to participate in each cake walk is collected at the beginning of each walk.

We are in need of **baked items that can be used as prizes for winners in the Cake Walk.** These items can be cakes, pies, cookies, cupcakes or any type of donated baked item. The donations should be wrapped or packaged appropriately (use disposable pans, bags, coverings, etc., as bakeware will not be returned.) Please avoid baked items that contain dairy items (cream, pudding, etc.) that could melt or spoil in hot weather.

Note: If you would like to visit a local business for a bakery donation, we would appreciate it. We have already contacted Perkins and Nothing But Bundt.

In the past, other popular prize items for the cake walk have been watermelons and cases of soda (or for today's popularity, a case of water). The more prizes we have, the more "walks" we can have and the more fun this event will be! Thanks for all your donations!

My name is Derek Altner, and I am currently working toward earning the rank of Eagle Scout with Troop 29 in Easton, PA.

As part of my Eagle Scout service project, I am organizing a project to help support the community by collecting and assembling first aid supplies for the homeless along with partnering with the Project of Easton. The goal of this project is to provide essential medical and safety items to those in need and help ensure that these supplies are readily available in emergency situations.

I am reaching out to ask if you would be willing to donate first aid supplies or related items to help support this effort. Some examples of needed items include:

Bandages and gauze	Ace bandages	Antibiotic ointment
Adhesive tape	Alcohol wipes	Disposable gloves
Instant cold packs	Mesh zipper pouches to use for holding kit items	
Medical scissors	Hydrocortisone cream	Burn Cream
Saline eye wash solution pods	Moleskin	Mini tweezers
Individual water purification tablets	Disposable Thermometer	First aid sting relief pads
Cooling Fever Relief Patches	Triple antibiotic	Iodine prep pads
Castile Soap towelettes	Facial Wipes	Hand sanitizer
